

Documents to be brought during SWAYAM course registration –

1. Photocopy of the last obtained education certificate (ie. the copy of degree certificate obtained before admission to JIS University)
2. Photocopy of ABC Id card.

Eligibility of the students to appear for the end term examinations of SWAYAM courses –

1. The student must register her/his name for the courses in the SWAYAM portal. All registrations are to be done under the supervision of the course mentors.
2. The student must complete the entire SWAYAM course.
3. The student must submit a minimum of 75% of the assignments and quizzes on SWAYAM platform.
4. The student must obtain a minimum of 75% attendance in the SWAYAM course tutorial classes conducted by the university.

The examination of SWAYAM courses will have two components –

1. Comprehensive Internal Assessment (CIA)
2. End Term Examination (ETE)

The detailed description is given below

Assessment component	Weightage (marks out of 100)	Pass marks	Conduction
Comprehensive Internal Assessment (CIA) • Assignments • Quizzes	30	12	To be conducted and evaluated by the SWAYAM Course Coordinator centrally (not at the university level)
End Term Examination (ETE)	70	28	To be conducted by NPTEL / NTA centrally or Theory paper of 3 hours to be conducted at the end of semester centrally by the University's Exam Section


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

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
General Information –

1. Students will have the option to give the ETE either through NPTEL / NTA, or through JIS University.
2. Each student will have to declare their choice of ETE immediately after the SWAYAM course registration.
3. A student once registered for ETE under NPTEL/NTA in SWAYAM platform, cannot change the choice afterwards. Such candidates will be considered absent in ETE if they do not appear for ETE under NPTEL/NTA.
4. Consideration criteria of end term marks –

ETE conduction by	ETE marks to be taken by the university
NPTEL / NTA	The exact marks as obtained in the NPTEL / NTA exam
University	Obtained marks will be normalized w.r.t. the standard of NPTEL/NTA

5. A student failing in CIA will not be allowed to appear for ETE.
6. The students who could not pass/appear in the End Term Examination shall be allowed a maximum of two chances to clear their backlogs in the subsequent two semesters.
7. **The student shall face a year-lag, if she/he is unable to clear the SWAYAM course backlog even after two subsequent attempts.**
8. If a student has passed in CIA but failed in ETE, the previously obtained marks in CIA will be carried to the subsequent semester.


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
